



Protocol for use of Becoming a Highly Effective School Self- Assessment

1. Self-assessment should be discussed and staff should evaluate their implementation of Effective School Practice.
2. Areas of strength should be to ensure the practice is systematic and will continue.
3. Areas of need should be further discussed and SMART goals developed along with an action plan to implement the practice to seek results.
4. The self-evaluation results, goals and action plans should be placed in a public display for the purpose of reminding staff and the community of the progress being made.
5. The action plan should have periodic times set for monitoring progress throughout the year (we recommend every six weeks).
